Rules of the tournament series

ChessStars Cup

- 1. The organizer of the tournament is the owner of the ChessStars website Paweł Kabat, 47/2 Praska Street, 30-329 Krakow, NIP: 6070032215
- 2. The tournament takes place on the Chess.com platform in the Chess.Stars Club. Participants must have an account on this platform.
- 3. Membership in the Chess.Stars Club is required to participate.
- 4. In order to participate in the semi-finals, players from 1st to 10th place in the qualifying tournament must take place. There will be 6 qualifier tournaments.
- 5. In order to participate in the finals, players from 1st to 15th place will be promoted. There will be 2 semi-final tournaments.
- 6. Players participating in the Semi-Finals and Finals will receive a link to the tournament at least 24 hours prior to the start of the tournament via a message on chess.com and to the email address provided by the player when registering with ChessStars.
- 7. One player has the right to participate in several qualifying tournaments. If it takes a long time to several times the place is rewarded, the promotion is not awarded to other players, and the number of players in the semi-finals is reduced.
- 8. In the Semi-Finals, the players will be divided according to the rankings from the chess.com website on the basis of equal distribution of the players' strength between the two tournaments.
- 9. The Organizer is not responsible for the proper operation of the Chess.com website and its availability. In case of technical problems, the organizer has the right to cancel the tournament, interrupt it and cancel the results, suspend the games and change the date of the tournament.
- 10. In special situations, the organizer has the right to cancel the tournament, about which the players will be informed through official communication channels.
- 11. The Chess.com platform has built-in fraud detection tools.

All batches will be monitored and analyzed for suspicious activity. If cheating is detected, the player will be disqualified and their results will be canceled.

12. Prizes will be awarded after verification of the fairness of the game of all players. In case of unfair play, the player is disqualified and the prize is forfeited.

Dishonesty can be found by the site administration Chess.com or independently by the organizer.

- 13. In the event of any doubt as to the integrity of a player, the release of prizes will be withheld until clarification.
- 14. Decisions of the Chess.com website administration and the organizer regarding fairness players are final.
- 15. A player must be a registered member of ChessStars in order to receive a prize.

- 16. The schedule can be found on the ChessStars.net Calendar page and in the Chess.Stars Club on Chess.com.
- 17. Prizes: 1st place: MOSOKI's Smart Watch, 2nd place: ChessStars T-Shirt, 3rd place: ChessStars Mug.
- 18. Winners will be contacted by the promoter to discuss how to claim their prizes.
- 19. The organizer will wait for the players' response for 7 days. During this time, it will try to contact the players several times. If they do not receive the necessary information within this time to transfer the prize, the prizes will be forfeited.
- 20. Once the necessary information has been provided by the players, the organizer will take the necessary measures to deliver the prizes as soon as possible.
- 21. By registering for the tournament, you agree to these rules.
